Cheshire Archives Services would like to invite you to a public consultation event, where you can have your say on the draft proposals for a new state of the art History Centre which will transform access to Cheshire's archives and ensure their preservation for future generations.

Cheshire Archives and Local Studies' current facility is no longer fit for purpose and proposals have been developed to rehouse the archive in two new bespoke history centres – one on the site of the old library building in Memorial Square, Crewe, and one in Chester.

These will be more accessible, inviting, and environmentally-friendly spaces which will ensure that documents can be held in suitable conditions. The centres will provide spaces for research, performances and exhibitions which all help to tell Cheshire's story from the archives.

This public consultation has been arranged to show you the proposals for Crewe and offer an opportunity for feedback to help shape a successful future vision for the site.
